

## Citizenship Policy Engineering 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

Offenses will be deducted from your total citizenship point count of 50. You are NOT able to "make-up" lost citizenship points. A new citizenship grade (a new 50 points) begins at every new SCHOOL progress-reporting period (every six weeks). All are averaged at the end of each semester for your report-card citizenship grade.
